

Trucks start their routes early- please place all items out for pick-up the night before or by 6:00AM on the day of pick-up

TRASH (T)

- Trash is picked up on Mondays & Thursdays (***except as noted**)
- Racks should be no higher than 18" on the street side. **ALL** cans **MUST** have lids

RECYCLING (R)

- All cans **MUST** have lids & holes in the bottom for drainage
- All cans **MUST** have stickers on the side & lid- stickers available at Borough Hall
- All items **MUST** be empty, rinsed & have the lids removed

Single Stream- ALL recyclable material goes together in one can- glass containers, aluminum, steel & aerosol cans (empty), plastic bottles (where the neck is smaller than the body), newspapers (w/ inserts), junk mail, magazines, catalogs, school/office papers & corrugated cardboard (flattened)

BRUSH (B)

- No greater than 4" in diameter, **MUST** be tied in bundles no larger than 2' x 4'. **Brush will not be picked up unless it is put out properly!**

LEAVES (L)

- **MUST** be put out in bags or loose in a can (with holes in the bottom for drainage)

TIRES

Residents can take standard car & truck tires to the Ocean County Recycling Center in Manahawkin- 7:30AM - 3:00PM, Mon. - Sat.

- Tires must be off the rim, in one piece & clean of all water, dirt & debris
- *applicable fees may apply**

MOTOR OIL

Can be brought to the Borough Yard 8:30AM-3:00PM weekdays. A receipt for \$2.00 for each gallon or part thereof of oil must first be obtained from the Borough Hall

ELECTRONICS

All electronics (televisions, computers, stereos, microwaves, phones, copiers, fax machines, etc.) are now banned from the landfill. Please call Borough Hall, 494-9196, for a pick-up.

Bulk Items

Bulk items such as furniture and mattresses are picked up on regular trash days, except during July and August

Construction Debris

Reminder- Construction debris (interior/exterior) **MUST** be removed by the homeowner or contractor

Refrigerators & Air Conditioners

If you have a refrigerator or air conditioner you must call the Borough Hall, 494-9196, to arrange for a pick-up, there is a \$20.00 charge per item. These items contain Freon and cannot go to the landfill!

Plastic Caps

Plastic caps are not recyclable. You can bring rigid plastic caps into the Borough Hall to be sent out to be recycled or throw them in the garbage.

Household Batteries

Household batteries go out with your regular household garbage. Rechargeable batteries can be dropped off at some retail stores, go to www.call2recycle.org for exact locations.

Telephone Books

Telephone books cannot be mixed in with the paper, they need to be recycled separately. There is a drop-off bin in the Recycling Yard (Public Works Yard)- West 10th Street. The gates are open Mon. - Fri., 8:00AM - 3:00PM

Propane Tanks

Will not be picked up at the curb. They must be taken to a propane dealer for proper disposal or taken to a Household Hazardous Waste site in the Spring or Fall.
