DO NOT BRING

- ASBESTOS
- CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS
- ELECTRONICS
- EXPLOSIVES (INCLUDES BOAT FLARES)
- INFECTIOUS WASTE ("RED BAG" WASTE)
- MEDICATIONS
- NEEDLES/ SYRINGES
- OXYGEN TANKS
- RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS
- SMOKE DETECTORS
- UNKNOWN/UNIDENTIFIABLE CHEMICALS

ALL MATERIALS (WITH EXCEPTION OF OIL AND GASOLINE) SHOULD BE IN ORIGINAL CONTAINERS
Limit 200 LBS dry materials & 20 gallons liquid Per household. No containers larger than 5 gallons.

Proof of residency required: driver's license or tax bill.
